Year 6 Data Analysis July 2019

Background Cohort Information

- 18 children (31%) were Pupil Premium/ Free School Meals.
- 5 children (9%) were SEND.
- 11 children (19%) were EAL. 1 joined in Y4; 2 joined in Y5 (1 being New to English).
- 5 children have left the cohort since the start of Y3.
- 10 children have joined the cohort after the start of Y3.
- Since the start of Year 5 3 children (5%) have joined the cohort and 6 (10%) have left the cohort.
- 5 children (9%) did not attend Warley Infants School.
- 3 children (5%) in the cohort were placed at Child Protection and/or Child in Need during Key Stage 2.
- 9 children (15%) had involvement from Sandwell Children’s Services/Sandwell Children’s Trust at some point during Key Stage 2.

Cohort Results

Data analysis is out of 59 children in the cohort.

As 1 child joined the school from Italy – an application for removing her from the SATs Tables can be made in September. Percentages in red are calculated without this child being included.
